Regulations on the use of mobile phones, smartwatches, and other electronic devices with capabilities for image and sound recording, briefly "smart objects."

Mobile phones and other digital devices not needed for class are neither visible nor audible on the school premises during teaching and care times.

Why are these rules in place?

The school provides sufficient digital devices for teaching.
Smart objects can be distracting and disrupt classes.
Smart objects can violate the privacy of others.

What should I do with private smart objects at school?

You stow smart objects in your school bag.
It is best to turn off smart objects or switch them to airplane mode.

Where and when do these rules apply?

The rules apply to the entire school premises, including after-school care and other care facilities.
The rules apply during official school and care times.
